


Top NYC Walking Tours in all 5 Boroughs

Little Island will once again host Creative Breaks, free artmaking activities (dance, music and visual art), for all ages, every Wednesday through Saturday beginning Wednesday, June 7 through Saturday, September 2. This season will also include the return of Teen Night on Fridays at 7:00 p.m.

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Explore Pier 57

At historic Pier 57, you can explore food, art, music, hands-on environmental education and more — always with spectacular views. Transformed from its original maritime industrial use through an award-winning historic restoration, Pier 57 features ample indoor and outdoor public space for year-round enjoyment.

Here you will find a rooftop park, a waterfront food market that celebrates NYC's independent food culture, City Winery, community spaces, and an interactive gallery and classroom focused on local wildlife and waterways. This pier is one of several locations in Hudson River Park where limited commercial uses are permitted to support the Park's overall care and operations.
