NYC Like a New Yorker - The Bronx

The Bronx is packed with New York City history and culture. It's where Babe Ruth became a baseball legend, where the sounds and styles of hip-hop were born and where you can feast on old-world classics in its own Little Italy.

Just a train ride north of Manhattan, the Bronx offers everything from the Bronx Zoo to world-famous Yankee Stadium. Take a stroll on the Grand Concourse or take a ferry from Manhattan to an idyllic waterfront spot called Clason Point. Explore unique and vibrant neighborhoods like Riverdale, where visitors can down a Guinness at An Beal Bocht, an authentic Irish pub; Arthur Avenue, the borough's very own Little Italy; and Mott Haven, where The Lit. Bar is an essential stop for book lovers and Chocobar Cortés is a must for chocolate lovers.

The Bronx Hotels

A lovely choice for accommodations in the Bronx is the boutique <u>Opera House</u> <u>Hotel</u>. It's located in a renovated historic theater that once hosted entertainment legends like Harry Houdini and the Marx Brothers. The hotel has 60 rooms, a gym, free breakfast, concierge service, and it's conveniently located near two subway stations.

The Bronx Restaurants

The Bronx is home to hundreds of restaurants, many of them friendly mom-and-pop establishments offering authentic cuisine from around the world, whether it's Colombian sancocho at <u>La Masa</u>, Mexican fare at <u>Taqueria Tlaxcalli</u>, Italian food on <u>Arthur Avenue</u> or West African food at Papaye, Bognan International and Grin.





The Bronx Attractions

The Bronx are most famous for <u>Yankee Stadium</u>, the Bronx Zoo, the <u>New York</u> <u>Botanical Garden</u> but it's also brimming with unique local experiences to explore. From waterfront destinations like <u>City Island</u> and Orchard Beach to Little Italy, the murals and restaurants along River Avenue to the most beautiful green spaces: <u>Wave Hill</u> and <u>Van Cortlandt Park</u>.

The Bronx Bridges

The Bronx is the only New York City borough that's not on an island. It's connected to the rest of the City by a multitude of bridges, and visitors can actually get to the Bronx by walking across some of them. Two of the most appealing pedestrian walkways are on the Henry Hudson Bridge and the High Bridge - New York's oldest bridge.





Getting to The Bronx

If you don't want to walk, The Bronx is easily accessible from Manhattan by subway, bus or simply take the NYC Ferry from Manhattan to the Bronx for just US \$2.75, the same price as a subway ride. To head to Pelham Bay Park, City Island and <u>Orchard Beach</u>-sometimes called the Bronx Riviera- just take the 6 train to the Pelham Bay Park station at the end of the line.
